Registration

The deadline for registrations for the event on October 3rd 2026 is August 21, 2026.

Registration does not guarantee a bout; however, the sooner you register, the greater the chance of securing a bout.

If the boxer(s) have not done so earlier this year, the registration form (see the link below) must be submitted as a signed hard copy.

Competition record book

All boxers must present their competition record book during the weigh-in/medical check.

If a boxer from a Curaçao club does not have one, it can be purchased by paying 10 guilders and providing a face photo and a completed registration form (see the link above).

Weigh-In & Medical Check

The weigh-in and medical check will take place on the same day as the competition, October 3rd. Time and location will be announced later.

Sanction for not meeting the agreed weight limit

We discourage weight cutting and emphasize registering boxers in “walking weight”.

If one fails to meet the weight limit, one also disadvantages the organization and the opponent, as his or her bout will not take place. Failure to meet the agreed weight limit results in losing the bout by walk-over and a temporary ban from participating in boxing competition.

Corner(wo)men List

Send the list of your corner(wo)men with a max of 3 persons per team, to info@boxing.cw before September 26, 2026. Check if they have all read and signed the code of conduct.

Entering the ring

Send the youtube link of your boxer(s) entrance song(s) to info@boxing.cw before September 26, 2026. Please consider if the songs contain any explicit language (swear words).

If a boxer has been called to enter the ring, (s)he has 1 minute to appear in the ring ready for the bout, so Vaseline must be applied before entering the ring. Only headgear are worn in the ring.

Rules, clothing/wear and equipment/gear

You are expected to be familiar with the rules, as you have declared by signing the registration form and the code of conduct. Below is a link to the summary of the rules.

The boxing gloves used during bouts are provided by CuraBox.

The rest, like footwear, mouthpiece, groinprotector, velcro bandages (professional handwraps with tape and gauze are NOT allowed), red and blue uniform, is the responsibility of the boxer and his/her team.

The boxer(s)' team must provide their own water, ice, and supplies such as a bucket, towel, etc.

Title and non-title boxing bouts and Thai boxing fights on the program

Based on previous results, it will be determined whether one is eligible to box for the championship title. If not, one may participate in a non-title bout.

If local fights can be matched, there will also be Thai boxing under the auspices of CUMAFE.
